James River Buffer Program

- The James River Buffer Program is a flexible cost-share option for landowners looking to install a riparian forest buffer. The program is run in partnership with the James River Association and is funded by the Virginia Environmental Endowment.

Emerald Ash Borer Cost Share

The 2023 Emerald Ash Borer Cost-Share will be open to landowners and organizations (e.g. municipalities, non-profits, educational institutions, and HOA's) *statewide*, with applications accepted from **April 20th-June 16th**. The program shares the cost of emamectin benzoate injection treatments for qualifying ash trees, up to 50%. There is a landowner maximum match of \$1,250 and an organization max of \$5,000, as well as a \$10,000 cap for cost-sharing per locality.

Silvicultural Water Quality Program

- Calendar year 2022 BMP implementation rate based on the quarterly audits: 96.8% statewide, 97.7% within the Chesapeake Bay watershed
- The Logger BMP Cost Share Program allocated \$252,000.00 of funding for 30 projects directly related to stream crossings on timber harvest operations during the time period of October -December 2022
- Riparian Buffer Tax Credit Program provided tax credits totaling \$462,596.26 on timber valued at \$2,356,689.40 that were retained in SMZ's on 73 timber harvests during the 2021 Tax Year.
